- (a) There are no dilapidated monuments under the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) in Gujarat. There are 203 Centrally Protected Monuments (CPM) in the state which are regularly conserved & maintained and they all are in good state of preservation.
- (b) The details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred on the conservation & maintenance of CPM's in Gujarat for the last three years are given as under:-
