Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of fund allocated, sanctioned and utilized under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) during the last three years and current year in the State of Chhattisgarh, district-wise;
- (b) the current status of sanctioned projects during the above period;
- (c) whether the Government has sanctioned the implementation of third phase of PMGSY;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the number of proposals for Rajnandgaon and Kabirdham districts in Chhattisgarh State?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

(a) The funds for the implementation of the scheme are released by the Ministry to the State as a whole. The funds to the States are released on the basis of works in hand, their execution capacity & performance and unspent balances of the previous releases available with them.

Reasons for delay in completion of these projects are delay in award of projects by the state, delay in getting forest clearance, inadequate response by the contractors and issues related to law & order.

- (c) & (d) In the year 2019, Government launched PMGSY-III for consolidation of 1,25,000 Km Through Routes and Major Rural Links connecting habitations, inter-alia, to Gramin Agricultural Markets (GrAMs), Higher Secondary Schools and Hospitals. State of Chhattisgarh has been allocated 5,612 Km of road length under PMGSY-III. The entire target length has been sanctioned to the State, and out of which, 4,611 Km of road length has been completed till 03.02.2022.
- (e) The details of works sanctioned to the Rajnandgaon and Kabirdham districts of Chhattisgarh State under PMGSY-III are as under:-
