RECRUITMENT OF PATRIOT YOUTH IN PARA-MILITARY FORCES

†1051. SHRI CHUNNI LAL SAHU:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes any scheme for recruiting patriotic youth living in border areas in para-military forces;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes any scheme for such recruitment drive every year;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

- (a) to (b): As per the existing scheme of examination for recruitment to the post of Constable (General Duty-GD) conducted by the Staff Selection Commission (SSC), 20% of the vacancies in Border Guarding Forces namely, Border Security Force (BSF), Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP), Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) and Assam Rifles (AR) are allotted to notified border districts, falling within the area of responsibility of the concerned border guarding force.
- (c) to (e): It has been decided to conduct recruitment of Constable (GD) through SSC on yearly basis.
