STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 1266 BY SHRI HIBI EDEN TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 09.02.2022 REGARDING ELECTRIFICATION OF RAILWAYS

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Railway tracks of the length of 48,330 Route Kilometer have been electrified upto 31.01.2022. Budget allocation of ₹7,542 crore has been kept for the Railway Electrification projects during 2021-22.

(c) Indian Railways do not run train services on state-wise basis as railway network straddles across State boundaries. Besides, introduction of trains is an ongoing process over Indian Railways subject to operational feasibility, traffic demand, availability of resources, etc.
