(a) & (b) : Yes Sir. As on 31.1.2022, total 17 States viz. Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, West Bengal, Bihar, Nagaland, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Madhya Pradesh, Kerala, Haryana, Jharkhand, Telangana, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Mizoram and Tripura have established Consumer Welfare (Corpus) Fund in their respective States. Remaining States/UTs viz. Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Chandigarh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, Delhi, Jammu & Kashmir, Lakshadweep, Puducherry and Ladakh have not established the Corpus fund in their States/UT.
