- (b) the details of allocation of funds for this project till now; and
- (c) the time by which the aforesaid railway line is likely to be completed and the facilities that would accrue to the passengers?

(a) to (c): Yavatmal-Murtizapur (113 km), Murtizapur-Achalpur (77 km) and Pulgaon-Arvi (35 km) (total 225 km) Narrow Gauge railway sections are parts of Shakuntala Railway owned by Central Provinces Railway Company (C.P. Railway). The proposal of gauge conversion of Shakuntala Railway was included in Capital Investment Programme 2017-18 in anticipation that State Government will take up the project in Joint Venture Mode.

However, presently the proposed Railway Line is not owned by Ministry of Railways and proposal of determination of Railways' Agreement with C.P. Railway is not final.
