**DISTRESS MSMEs IN MADHYA PRADESH**

1421. SHRI SHANKAR LALWANI:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of distressed MSMEs during the last three years in Madhya Pradesh, district-wise;
- (b) the number of MSMEs which have been at the brink of closure due to Covid-19 in Madhya Pradesh, district-wise; and
- (c) the steps taken /being taken by the Government to revive these MSMEs?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c): Under the Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Package, the government has taken a number of steps to revive MSMEs that were affected during COVID-19 pandemic. One of these steps was the launch of the Credit Guarantee Scheme for Subordinate Debt in 2020, with a view to provide credit facility to the promoters of stressed MSMEs viz. Special Mention Account-2 (SMA-2) and Non-Performing Asset (NPA) accounts who are eligible for restructuring as per RBI guidelines on the books of lending institutions. Under the scheme, the promoter infuses credit in the MSME as quasi equity or sub-debt. Since the launch of the scheme, in the state of Madhya Pradesh guarantees amounting to Rs. 3.66 crore have been issued to 42 number of MSMEs till 30.12.2021.
