INSTALLATION OF ROOFTOP SOLAR PANEL

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the targeted households for installation of the rooftop solar panel in the current financial year;
- (b) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to promote the resident individuals to install solar panel at their rooftop; and
- (c) the details of solar subsidy allocated during the current financial year till December 2021 for the said purpose?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) is implementing Rooftop Solar Programme Phase II, targeting installation of aggregated 4000 MW capacity rooftop solar plants in the residential sector through central financial assistance. Against this target capacity of 4000 MW, based on the demand received from states, around 3162 MW capacity has been allocated to state implementing agencies including 1598.8 MW capacity which has been allocated in FY 2021-22. Cumulatively, around 1176 MW capacity has been reported installed as on 31.12.2021.

Implementation of the Programme is being reviewed from time to time to make it effective in delivering the targeted benefits and guidelines are amended accordingly. Recently MNRE has issued procedure for simplification of Rooftop Solar Programme allowing household owner to get the rooftop solar plant installed by themselves or through any vendor of their choice.

During the current financial year till December 2021, an amount of around Rs. 1152 Crore has been released to various state implementing agencies in the country under the Programme.
