(a)to(d) In accordance with Hon'ble Prime Minister's announcement at COP26, Ministry of New and Renewable Energy is committed to achieving 500 GW of installed electricity capacity from non-fossil fuel sources by 2030.

Most of renewable energy projects in the country are being set up by private sector developers selected through a transparent bidding process. Private sector developers identify locations for setting up renewable energy projects depending upon availability of the renewable energy resource, land and power evacuation infrastructure, and certain other factors.
