- (b) whether the students living in the periphery of the steel plants will be given priority in selection for professional courses and if so, the details of the steps taken thereon?

(a)&(b) Under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) program, Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) sponsors youths living in the periphery of the SAIL Plants and Mines for training in Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in various trades like Fitter, Electrician, Mechanist, Turner, etc. .

The eligibility criteria for undergoing these ITI training is matriculation and financial status of the parents. The needy matriculate students living in the periphery of the Steel Plants and Mines are given priority in selection for sponsorship of their ITI training.
