(a) to (e): Ministry of MSME is implementing a major credit-linked subsidy programme named Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) since 2008-09 with Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) as nodal agency at the national level for generating employment opportunities in the country including all districts of Rajasthan by setting up of micro-enterprises in the non-farm sector.

State-wise details of amount disbursed, including all districts of Rajasthan, along with the number of beneficiaries under PMEGP during the last five years and the current year are given at Annexure-I.

State-wise details of the total number of women and minority owned MSMEs, including all districts of Rajasthan, that have been granted loans under PMEGP during the last five years and the current year are given at Annexure-II.
