Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the financial assistance allocated from 2020 to 2021 for water supply in rural areas;
- (b) the details of proposals received from the State of Maharashtra under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) along with the present status thereof;
- (c) the details of proposals from Osmanabad district in Maharashtra which have been sanctioned under JJM along with the funds allocated for the purpose?

(a) Since August 2019, Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household by 2024. The State/ UT-wise details of fund allocated under JJM during 2020-21 to 2021-22 is at **Annex**.

(b) to (c) States plan, design, approve and implement drinking water supply schemes as Drinking Water is a State subject. Government of India supplements the efforts of the States by providing technical and financial assistance. As such details of individual projects/ schemes for rural water supply projects are not maintained at the Government of India level.
