PRECAUTION 3RD DOSE VACCINATION

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to speed up the precaution 3rd dose vaccination process in view of rising cases and new strain of virus causing COVID-19, if so, the details thereof and the action taken in this regard;
- (b) whether the Government has fixed the target of precaution 3rd dose of COVID-19 vaccination to the healthcare/frontline workers, if so, the details thereof and if not, the steps taken to speed up precaution 3rd dose vaccination of healthcare/frontline workers to enable them to effectively tackle rising cases of COVID-19 and its new strain; and
- (c) whether the Government has any data regarding the number of deaths after two dose of immunization process as on date, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) The administration of precaution dose to Health Care Workers, Front Line Workers and persons aged 60 years and above has started under National COVID-19 Vaccination Programme from 10th January 2022. As on 8th February 2022, a total of 1,53,26,714 precaution doses have been administered to the eligible population, out of which 37,00,573 doses have been administered to Health Care Workers, 48,84,424 doses to Front Line Workers and 67,41,717 doses to persons aged 60 years and above with comorbidities.

Adequate Covid-19 vaccine doses are made available to States/UTs to vaccinate all eligible beneficiaries with 1st dose, 2nd dose and precaution dose.

States/UTs-wise data regarding the number of deaths reported as Adverse Events Following Immunization (AEFI) in individuals after 2nd dose of COVID-19 vaccine is at Annexure I.
