FUNDS ALLOCATED UNDER NATIONAL DIGITAL HEALTH MISSION

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated for Maharashtra under National Digital Health Mission, district-wise;
- (b) whether digital health card has been supplied to all citizens in Maharashtra, if so, the details thereof, district-wise; and
- (c) the details of proposals submitted by the State Government for issuing digital health card; and the action taken thereon?

(a) to (c) Union Government provides financial assistance to States/UTs through Programme Implementation Plan under National Health Mission for implementation and strengthening of health IT programmes and initiatives. Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) aims to create a platform enabling interoperability of health data within health ecosystem to create longitudinal Electronic Health Record (EHR) for every citizen. ABHAs (Health IDs) are digital public goods created by the Union Government to enable interoperable exchange of health records. As on 2nd February, 2022, a total of 1,34,46,898 ABHAs have been created in Maharashtra. The health ID generated digitally can serve as digital health card. The district wise detail is at Annexure.
