1716. SHRI ABDUL KHALEQUE:

Will the Minister of WOMEN CHILD AND DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of shelter homes for women trafficking survivors under the Ujjawala and Swadhar Greh programs in each State and Union Territory;
- (b) whether the Government has any proposal for setting up more homes for women trafficking survivors under the Ujjawala and Swadhar Greh programmes; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof with special reference to Assam?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) Government runs Ujjawala Scheme for prevention of trafficking and rescue, rehabilitation and re-integration of victims of trafficking for commercial sexual exploitation. Swadhar Greh Scheme caters to primary needs of women in difficult circumstances and aims to rehabilitate such women in difficult circumstance economically and emotionally. The number of shelter homes under the Ujjawala and Swadhar Greh Schemes are at Annexure.
- (b) and (c) Ujjawala and Swadhar Greh Schemes are demand driven schemes and sanction for new homes is given on receipt of proposals from the State Government/UT Administration as per Scheme Guidelines.
