(b) The allocated funds cater to the Committed Liabilities and New Schemes of the Armed Forces under Capital Acquisition (Modernisation) head. These funds are optimally utilized towards operational activities and if required, the schemes are reprioritized to ensure that urgent and critical capabilities are acquired without any compromise to operational preparedness of Defence Services.
