- (a) The Ministry of Ayush has mandate to develop AYUSH medicinal programs viz. Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha, Sowa-Rigpa and Homoeopathy.

Apart from the programs mentioned above, the Ministry also include Yoga and Naturopathy which are non-medicinal health care systems.

- (b) The State/UT wise details of institutes which are providing education and training in medicinal programs including Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha, Sowa-Rigpa and Homoeopathy under National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH), are attached as **Annexure-I**.
