#### **ROBs IN JAUNPUR**

#### 180. SHRI SHYAM SINGH YADAV:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that Jaunpur district is surrounded by railway lines from all the sides which leads to large traffic jams in the city;
- (b) if so, whether the Government intends to build Rail Over Bridge (ROB) on all the railway crossings in Jaunpur district to tackle the problem of traffic jams;
- (c) if so, the details of the ongoing ROB projects in Jaunpur district at present;
- (d) the status of each ROB project as on date;
- (e) whether any project is lagging behind schedule; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

(a) to (f): Two Railway lines Zafrabad-Jaunpur City-Sultanpur and Zafrabad-Faizabad pass through the Jaunpur city. At present there are 7 level crossings (LCs) and 1 ROB for public to cross the tracks. Two ROBs at LC No. 42A and 43A have been sanctioned by Railways during the year 2016-17 on cost sharing basis with State Govt. of Uttar Pradesh. However, the work of approaches has not been sanctioned by State Govt.

On the basis of consent of cost sharing, one ROB at LC No. 9B has been shortlisted for sanction during 2022-23.

Consent for cost sharing from State Govt. is awaited in respect of other four ROBs at LC Nos. 4 Spl., 5B, 6A & 38A.
