1808. SHRIMATI BHAVANA PUNDALIKRAO GAWALI:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features and objectives of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme along with the names of all districts identified under the said scheme;
- (b) whether aspirational districts have been identified to monitor the progress of BBBP scheme and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the targets set and achievements made under the scheme so far, State/UT-wise;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to implement the above scheme in all districts of Maharashtra and if so, the names of the districts where it has already been implemented;
- (e) the funds allocated, released and utilised so far under the said scheme since its inception, State/UT-wise including Maharashtra; and
- (f) the other measures taken by the Government to improve the functioning of the scheme?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT
(SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) & (b) Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) Scheme aims to address declining Child Sex Ratio (CSR) and related issues of empowerment of girls and women over a life cycle continuum. The objectives of the scheme is to prevent gender biased sex selective elimination, to ensure survival and protection of the girl child and to ensure education and participation of the girl child. The key elements of the scheme include nation-wide media and advocacy campaign and multi-sectoral intervention in selected districts. 405 districts including 51 aspirational districts (as identified by NITI Aayog) are covered through Multi- sectoral intervention component of BBBP. Name of 405 districts is at **Annexure-I**

(c) BBBP aims to address the issues of declining Child Sex Ratio (CSR). CSR is calculated on decadal basis by Registrar General of India through Census. As per the latest available report of Health Management Information System (HMIS), data of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare suggests an improving trend of 19 points at National level from 918 (2014- 15) to 937 (2020- 21). The State/UT wise SRB of 2014-15 and 2020-21 is at **Annexure-II**.

(d) Under the scheme, 31 Districts (as per Census 2011) of State of Maharashtra have been identified for multi sectoral intervention . The list of districts of Maharashtra may be seen at **Annexure-I**. All districts of the country including from State of Maharashtra are covered through multi- sectoral intervention during the 15th Finance Commission period.

(e) Details of State & UT-wise funds allocated, released and utilized under the scheme during last 5 years and current F.Y. 2021-22 is at **Annexure-III**.

(f) Consistent efforts are made under BBBP at all levels to generate awareness about the rights of girl child through community engagement, stop sex selection at birth and encourage positive action to support their education growth and development. Convergent efforts are made in collaboration with other Ministries and stakeholders. The implementation of the Scheme is monitored by Task Force constituted under BBBP at District, State and National level.
