1844. SHRI S. VENKATESAN:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the total sex-wise Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) of the students upto 12th Classes and Higher Education, State-wise;
- (b) the sex-wise GER among the students upto 12th and Higher education level among OBCs, SCs, STs, State-wise; and
- (c) the remedial steps proposed by the Government to improve GER among OBC, SC, ST students?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (b): The Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education has developed the Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+) system to record data on indicators of school education provided by all the States and Union Territories. As per UDISE+, the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) for primary, upper primary, secondary, higher secondary levels of school education and Higher education, for overall, scheduled castes and scheduled tribes, Gender-wise, State-wise are given at Annexure.

(c): Government of India launched Samagra Shiksha – an Integrated Scheme for school education, w.e.f. 2018-19, as an overarching programme for the school education sector extending from pre-school to class XII and aims to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education at all levels of school education.

The scheme focuses on identifying out of school children and their mainstreaming by providing financial assistance to the States and UTs for various activities to reduce dropouts at secondary level, which include opening/ strengthening of new schools up to senior secondary level, strengthening school infrastructure, setting up, up-gradation and running of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBV) upto class 12, setting up of residential schools/ hostels named Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Avasiya Vidyalayas, transport allowance, undertaking enrolment drives, seasonal hostels/ residential camps, provision of vocational education and ICT facilities in schools, financial assistance for aids and appliances for children with special needs, etc.

In order to increase the enrolment in higher educational institution, various measures have been taken by Government which includes issuing of new UGC regulation for Open and Distance Learning that allows entry of reputed institutions to offer education on the distance mode, using of ICT technology –SWAYAM portal to reach out to people and allow them to secure good quality education, encouraging opening of institution by State Governments through the Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) to achieve equity, access and excellence in higher education. The scheme supports components such as upgrading autonomous college to universities, clustering colleges to establish a university, setting up of new professional colleges in un-served and underserved areas as well as providing infrastructure grants to universities and colleges to scale up capacity. Scholarship programmes are offered to supplement the cost of education. Moreover, Higher Education Financing Agency (HEFA) has been established under the Companies Act, 2013 to leverage funds from market to finance improvement in infrastructure in top institutions of education.
