Will the Minister of DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has proposed to implement the scheme, namely Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East Region (PM-DevINE);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the PM-DevINE is proposed to fund infrastructure, in the spirit of PM GatiShakti and social development projects in North-East;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken/being taken by the Government under PM-DevINE including the budgetary provisions made therein?

ANSWER

The Minister of the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region [Shri G. Kishan Reddy]

(a) to (e) Yes Sir. A new scheme, Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East (or PM-DevINE) has been announced in Union Budget 2022-23, which will fund infrastructure in the spirit of PM Gati Shakti, and social development projects based on felt needs of the North-East. PM-DevINE will enable livelihood activities for youth and women by filling the gaps in various sectors, but it will not be a substitute for existing Central or State schemes. An initial allocation of Rs.1,500 crore has been made, as per Budget speech for 2022-23; and the initial list of projects is given in Table 1 below.
