#### **EKLAVYA MODEL RESIDENTIAL SCHOOLS (EMRS)**

#### 1872. SHRI ARVIND DHARMAPURI: SHRI BASANTA KUMAR PANDA: SHRI MARGANI BHARAT:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any plan to open Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) across the country; if so, the details thereof;

(b) the details of the approved EMRS in Odisha including Kalahandi and Nuapada districts Addateegala and Rampachodavaram in East Godavari Districts of Andhra Pradesh and names of Districts in Telangan where EMRS exist;

(c) whether there are any proposals for setting up more EMRS in the State of Telangana and if so, the details thereof;

(d) the details of the funds allocated and expenditure incurred in setting up and running these schools; and

(e) the details of facilities provided in the EMRS?

# ANSWER

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SMT. RENUKA SINGH SARUTA)

(a): Government has decided to establish Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS) in every block with more than 50% ST population and at least 20,000 tribal persons. A total number of 740 EMRSs are scheduled to be established; out of which 672 EMRSs have already been approved and 367 EMRSs are reported to be functional across the country.

(b) and (c): The details of approved EMRSs in Odisha including Kalahandi and Nuapada districts, Addateegala and Rampachodavaram in East Godavari Districts of Andhra Pradesh and the name of districts having EMRS in Telangana is enclosed at **Annexure**. All the blocks in Telangana fulfilling the criteria mentioned in part (a) have already been sanctioned an EMRS by the Ministry. A total number of 23 EMRSs have been sanctioned for the State of Telangana and all are reported to be functional as on date.

(d): Government has decided to incease the construction cost of EMRS to Rs.38.00 crore for plain areas and Rs. 48.00 crore in Northeast, hilly and LWE affected areas and the recurring cost is Rs.1.09 lakh per student per annum. Under the scheme of EMRS, Ministry releases fund to National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS) (an autonomous body under this Ministry) for further release to State Societies and construction agencies. The details of fund allocated under the scheme and fund released to NESTS by this Ministry during the last year and current year is as under:

(e): The facilities being provided in the EMRSs are as under:

- i. State-of-the-art infrastructure (School, Labs, Hostel, Sports Facility, Staff Residences etc.)
- ii. Study materials, uniforms (including customized climatic clothing for hilly areas)
- iii. Facilities for preparatory classes for competitive entrance examinations.
- iv. Remedial classes for weak students.
- v. Medical facilities including telemedicine and tie up with prominent hospitals in the vicinity.
- vi. Facilities for diagnostic and remedial medical needs of tribal children (e.g. Sickle Cell Anemia, Tuberculosis, Malaria etc.) will be ensured wherever possible.
- vii. Special Nutritional requirement and provisions for menstrual hygiene (sanitary pads, incinerator, etc.) of girl students.
- viii. Provision of adequate purified drinking water and sanitation facilities.
- ix. Scouts, Guides, NCC, School bands and related activities.
- x. Extra-curricular activities like dance, music, painting, trekking, excursions/ exposure visits, study tours will be a part of the curriculum.
- xi. Participation in school level competitions in various spheres including academics, sports and cocurricular.
- xii. Mobile app and robust MIS for reporting/ monitoring.
- xiii. Use of technology enabled learning tools.
