Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the percentage of Government schools with internet connection in all the State including Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) the percentage of schools equipped with computer labs along with adequate seating capacity;
- (c) whether the Government plans to extend the internet connectivity to all the schools across the country;
- (d) if so, the progress made in this regard so far;
- (e) whether the Government has set any target for making internet connectivity available in all the schools; and
- (f) if so, the details of the progress made in this regard in Chittorgarh, Pratapgarh and Udaipur districts of Rajasthan?

# ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRIMATI ANNPURNA DEVI)

- (a) As per UDISE 2019-20, State/UT-wise number and percentage of Government schools, with Internet connection/ facilities, including Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh are at Annexure-I.
- (b) As per UDISE 2019-20, State/UT-wise number and percentage of Government schools, with ICT/ Computer Labs, including Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh are at Annexure-II.

(c) to (f) The Government has taken various steps to provide online education amidst COVID-19 pandemic. These include PRAGYATA Guidelines on various modes of digital education including online mode that depends more on availability of internet, partially online mode that utilizes the blended approach of digital technology and other offline activities, offline mode that utilizes television and radio as a major medium of instruction of education.
