(a) to (c): Ministry of Tribal Affairs has provided financial assistance to Government of Andhra Pradesh under the scheme of Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) during last three years against the activities related to education, health, sanitation, water supply, livelihood, skill development etc. as at **Annexure**. Details of provision of funds to various districts in the State is not maintained by the Ministry.
