#### ALLOCATION OF TEXTILE INDUSTRY

#### 193. SHRI MOHAMMED FAIZAL P.P.:

#### Will the Minister of TEXTILES वस्त्र मंत्री

be pleased to state :

(a) the allocations made for Textile Industry during the last three years;

(b) the percentage of decrease/increase over the allocations made during this period, Sector-wise;

(c) whether any new scheme has been launched for the development of Textile Sector during the last three years; and

(d) if so, the details of the schemes along with the targets fixed for achievement?

### उत्तर ANSWER वस्त्र राज्य मंत्री (**श्रीमती दर्शना जरदोश**) THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR TEXTILES (SMT. DARSHANA JARDOSH)

(a) & (b): The details of the allocations made under various schemes implemented by Ministry of Textile during the last three years on pan-India basis are given at **Annexure**.

(c) & (d): The Government has launched following Schemes in last three years. Brief of the Schemes is as under:-

- i) The Government has approved setting up of Seven PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites with an outlay of Rs. 4445 crore for a period of seven years upto 2027-28. These parks will enable the textile industry to become globally competitive, attract large investment and boost employment generation.
- ii) The Government has approved the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Textiles, with an approved outlay of Rs 10683 crore, to promote production of MMF Apparel, MMF Fabrics and Products of Technical Textiles in the country to enable Textile sector to achieve size and scale and to become competitive.
- iii) The scheme of Rebate of State and central Taxes and Levies (RoSCTL) effective from March 2019 has been continued till 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024 for Exports of Apparel / Garments and made-ups in order to make the textile sector competitive in international market.
- iv) With a view to position India as a global leader in Technical Textiles, National Technical Textile Mission was introduced in March 2021 with an outlay of Rs. 1480 crore; with a four year implementation period from Financial Year 2020-21 to 2023-24.
