ADIP SCHEME IN RAJASTHAN

2133. SHRI HANUMAN BENIWAL:

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of camps held under Assistance to Disabled Person Fitting of Aids and Appliances(ADIP) Scheme and number of divyang persons selected and the category under which they were benefited in Rajasthan, district-wise;
- (b) whether the State Government of Rajasthan has sent proposals to the Government for administrative and financial approval of the proposals under the said scheme;
- (c) if so, the action taken by the Government for approval of such proposals; and
- (d) the number of applications received from the State of Rajasthan for treatment and surgery etc. under the said scheme and the time by which said applications likely to be approved?

ANSWER

- (a). The details of district-wise camps held under the Scheme of 'Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase/Fitting of Aids and Appliances (ADIP)' in the State of Rajasthan and the number of Divyangjan of various category benefitted during the last three years and current year is at Annexure.
- (b)& (c) During the current financial year, proposals of two implementing agencies have been received with the recommendations of State Government of Rajasthan for release of grant-in-aid under the ADIP Scheme. Out of these two proposals, an amount of Rs. 2.50 crore has been released in one proposal for distribution of aids and assistive devices, including corrective surgery, wherever required, to eligible Divyangjan.
- (d) There is limited provision under the ADIP Scheme for surgery and treatment. Like, under the ADIP Scheme, assistance is provided for essential medical/surgical correction and interventions, prior to fitment of aids and appliances. Further, there is a provision under the ADIP Scheme for cochlear implant surgery in children with hearing impairment. During 2021-22, total 29 applications were received for cochlear implant surgery. Out of these, cochlear implant surgeries have been conducted in 15 eligible children with hearing impairment. Receipt of applications for cochlear implant surgery is a continuous process.
