(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The Government has initiated steps to formulate a New Cooperation Policy in consultation with stakeholders including various Ministries/Departments of Central Government, State Governments, Cooperative Federations, etc. Till date, inputs and suggestions from 51 stakeholders, including 18 Ministries/Departments, 12 State Governments and 10 Cooperative Federations have been received. The updated policy will serve as a framework for the plans and actions for promotion, strengthening and development of cooperatives across the country.
