(a to d): As such there is no Regional Model Floriculture Centre in the country established by Government of India. However, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare has sanctioned Centre of Excellence (CoE) on Floriculture with technical cooperation of Israeli and Dutch experts in following 6 states under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH):-
