MAHILA KISAN SASHAKTIKARAN PARIYOJANA UNDER NRLM

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) in Andhra Pradesh during the last financial year, district-wise;
- (b) the amount released to Andhra Pradesh under the scheme during the last three years;
- (c) the number of women beneficiaries under Mahila Kisan Sashaktikaran Pariyojana under NRLM in the State;
- (d) whether the Government has conducted any awareness programmes on nutrition and food security issues for the beneficiaries; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) is a demand driven Programme. The funds are released by the Central Government to the State Government and not district wise. The funds allocated to the Andhra Pradesh in the last financial year, 2020-21 were Rs. 134.48 crores.

(b) The amount released to Andhra Pradesh under DAY-NRLM during the last three years is as below :-

Year	Central Fund Release (Rs. in Crore)
2018-19	119.22
2019-20	166.52
2020-21	201.72

(c) In Andhra Pradesh 13,19,371 women beneficiaries under Mahila Kisan Sashaktikaran Pariyojana (MKSP), a sub-scheme under DAY-NRLM have been covered.

(d) & (e) Yes sir. The Andhra Pradesh Society for Elimination of Rural Poverty (AP SERP) that is implementing DAY-NRLM in the State of Andhra Pradesh has created awareness on backyard poultry, Nutri Gardens, Dietary Diversification to prevent Anaemia and Malnutrition. More than 82 lakh SHG women participated in these awareness programmes on nutrition and food security in Andhra Pradesh.
