Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to State:

- (a) whether the Indian Railways has plans to become 'Net-Zero Carbon Emitter' by 2030;
- (b) if so, whether the Railways plans to use its 20% parking capacity at railway stations or office complex for setting up electronic vehicle charging infrastructure; and
- (c) if so, the detailed plan chalked out by Railways for using its infrastructure for electronic charging facilities especially at railway stations where such vehicles are likely to increase in the near future?
