Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has assessed the performance and profitability of coal mines including Coal India Ltd in the country and if so, the names of the coal mines which are running in profit/losses and the reasons for loss;
- (b) the details of the coal mines which are likely to be closed down after completion of the extraction work and the total decline registered in coal production due to abandoning/closing down of these coal mines along with the estimated loss to be incurred thereby in future;
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to make good/compensate the losses/ shortages in the coal production;
- (d) whether the Government has formulated any scheme for the exploration and operation of small/closed/ abandoned coal mines and new mining regions and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the other steps taken by the Government to increase domestic coal production and also profitability of coal mines?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS, COAL AND MINES (SHRI PRALHAD JOSHI)

- (a) Yes Sir. Company wise details of the coal mines which are running in profit/losses and reasons for losses are as below:
 - (i) Coal India Limited (CIL): CIL has 352 mines as on 01.04.2020. Out of 352 mines, the names of the coal mines which are running in profit/losses are enclosed as **Annexure A and Annexure B.**

Following are the main reasons for losses in loss making Mines in CIL:

- Cost of production is very high due to high manpower cost.
- Low production of coal.
- (ii) NLC India Limited (NLCIL): Other than Lignite, NLCIL has one operating Coal Mine located in Odisha which is having capacity of 20 MTPA and the same is in profit.
- (iii) Singareni Coal and Collieries Limited (SCCL): Out of 44 mines of SCCL presently in operation, 27 mines are incurring loss (including all UG mines). List of 44 mines is enclosed in Annexure C.

Losses in underground mines is mainly due to higher cost of production due to old and extensive mines and higher wages. Some opencast mines are having higher stripping ratio.

- **(b)** The company wise details of coal mines which are likely to be closed down after completion of the extraction work are as under:
- (i) Coal India Limited (CIL): The details of coal mines likely to be closed down in near future after completion of extraction is attached in Annexure D.

However, there will be no decline in production in CIL due to this as new mines are opened and capacity enhancement of existing mines are taken up.

(ii) Singareni Coal and Collieries Limited (SCCL): The details of coal mines of SCCL likely to be closed in next 3 years is attached in **Annexure E**

In SCCL, mines are closed either due to exhaustion of reserves or conversion to opencast for better conservation, production, productivity and safety. New mines are planned to compensate the potential loss and augment the production.

(c) Losses in production due to the abandoning/closing down of above coal mines is compensated either by opening of new projects or increasing production capacity of running projects. As such there are no losses due to the abandoning/closing down of these coal mines.

CIL has approved 36 coal mining projects including greenfield and brownfield expansion projects in financial year 2020-21 with an incremental capacity of about 221 Million tones per year. There are 118 coal mining projects under different stage of implementation. Out of these, 73 projects are producing coal and remaining projects will commence production in phased manner after fulfillment of resource requirements like acquisition & possession of land, grant of EC and FC and other mining infrastructures. Out of 73 Projects in production, 68 Projects will contribute more production by achieving their rated capacity. To expedite the implementation of projects, CIL has planned 15 projects to be implemented through Mine Developer cum Operator (MDO) route.

SCCL has planned to enhance its production to 80 MT by the year 2024-25 and 100 MT by the year 2030 from present level of 65 MT by opening 10 new mines (8 in Godavari valley coal fields in Telangana and 2 in Odisha).

- (d) The Government is taking steps for exploitation/operation of discontinued/closed /abandoned mines of CIL, having considerable coal reserves through private participation in revenue sharing mode. One round of stakeholder's consultation has already taken place in this direction.
- (e) In order to increase domestic Coal Production, 72 new Coal Projects with total capacity of about 545 million Tonnes, have been identified. Out of these 72 Projects, 15 Projects of CIL and 2 Projects of NLCIL have been identified for MDO mode of operation for faster augmentation of coal Production.

Other steps taken by the Government to increase domestic production and also profitability are as below:

- (i) Methodology for auction of coal and lignite mines / blocks for sale of coal/lignite on revenue sharing basis and tenure of coking coal linkage were approved by CCEA on 20.05.2020 and order in this regard was issued on 28.05.2020. Through this methodology the thrust of the Government is to maximize domestic production. It enables adequate competition and faster development of coal blocks. It is oriented to make maximum coal available in the market at the earliest. Auction process for auction of coal blocks for sale of coal has been launched on 18.06.2020.
- (ii) Regular Monitoring: A Monitoring Committee has been constituted under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Coal) with Chief Secretaries from respective Host States, Secretary (MoEF& CC), Coal Controller Organisation (CCO) & CMPDIL as members of the Committee to conduct regular reviews and to expedite the development of blocks.
- (iii) Enactment of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Amendment Act, 2021: The Act provides that captive mines owners (other than atomic minerals) may sell up to 50% of their annual mineral (including coal) production in the open market after meeting the requirement of the end use plant linked with the mine in such manner as may be prescribed by the Central Government and on payment of such additional amount. This step is an attempt to stimulate the coal block allocattees to commence coal production early.
- (iv) Amendments have been made in the CMSP Act to ensure wider participation and competition in auction of coal mines.
- (v) Project Management Unit (PMU): Project Management Unit has been appointed by Ministry for handholding of coal block allottees for obtaining various approvals / clearances for early operationalisation of coal mines.
- (vi) Single Window Clearance: The Union government has launched Single Window Clearance portal on 11.01.2021 for the coal sector to speed up the operationalisation of coal mines. It is an unified platform that facilitates grant of clearances and approvals required for starting a coal mine in India. Now, the complete process is facilitated through Single Window Clearance Portal, which will map not only the relevant application formats, but also process flow for grant of approvals or clearances. Mining Plan Block module is already operational.
