Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of mail express trains that are being operated by Indian Railways in comparison to its earlier operations despite challenges posed by Covid so far;
- (b) the time by which all the trains from all important places of the country particularly from Gujarat are likely to be made fully operational; and
- (c) the time by which the stoppages of trains that were suspended earlier are likely to be restored?

(a) to (c) To prevent the spread of COVID-19 pandemic, Indian Railways had discontinued all regular passenger carrying trains w.e.f. 23rd March, 2020. The train services are being resumed and are increased in a phased manner. As on 10th March, 2022, Indian Railways have resumed operation of 99 percent of Mail/Express train services, operated during pre-Covid Period, which are being operated as per rationalised time table.
