STOPPAGE OF TRAINS AT LATEHAR

†2477. SHRI SUNIL KUMAR SINGH:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether train numbers 18635-18636, 18310-18311, 12874-12873 and 13025-13026 had stoppage at Latehar railway station but presently these trains are not stopping at this station;

(b) if so, the reasons to discontinue stoppage of these trains at the said station; and

(c) the time by which stoppage of these trains is likely to start at the said station?

(a) to (c) Latehar station is presently being adequately served by 09 pairs of train services including 18310 Jammu Tawi-Sambalpur Express. The average number of passengers and earnings, at Latehar, for 18635/18636 Ranchi-Sasaram Express, 18311/18312 Sambalpur-Varanasi Express, 12873/12874 Hatia-Anand Vihar Jharkhand Express and 13025/13026 Howrah-Bhopal Express is less than the norms prescribed in the extant policy guidelines relating to provision of stoppages.
