Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that the State of Gujarat has 1600 Km of coastal highways;**
- (b) if so, the details of stretches of the coastal highways that have been upgraded into four lanes;**
- (c) whether the Government has any plan to upgrade the entire stretch of these coastal highways into four lanes;**
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the funds earmarked for the purpose; and**
- (e) the time by which such work is likely to be completed?**

ANSWER

- (a) Yes Sir.**
- (b) 4-laning of projects comprising about 620 Km length of coastal highway with cost of Rs. 7,950 crore have been completed.**
- (c) to (e) At present construction works of projects comprising length of 520 Km with cost of Rs. 8,036 crore are ongoing. The physical progress of these works is varying from 3.5% to 92.19%. These works are targeted for completion by 2022-23. However, at present, no Detailed Project report (DPR) is in progress.**
