(a)to(d) Ministry of New and Renewable Energy(MNRE) is implementing various programmes / schemes for the development of renewable energy in the country, including in the State of Uttarakhand and the Bundelkhand region.

MNRE has approved the following solar parks in the Bundelkhand region under the scheme "Development of Solar Parks and Ultra Mega Solar Power Projects".
