CONSTRUCTION OF FLYOVER IN KERALA

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal for construction of a flyover near Thiruvarettukavu temple located at 529+800 LHS in the proposed Attingal bypass on National Highway-66 in Kerala;**
- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof;**
- (c) whether the Government proposes to convene a meeting of all the concerned stakeholders for execution of this long pending project at the earliest; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

(a) to (d) A reference has been received from Adv. Adoor Prakash, Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) for construction of a flyover near Thiruvarettukavu temple in order to save a portion of temple building. The temple is located at km 529.800 (LHS) of National Highway (NH) 66. 6-laning work of the stretch from Kadambattukonam to Kazhuttom of NH-66 including Attingal bypass has already been awarded on 03.03.2022. The alignment of this stretch at temple location is designed in such a way that there is no damage to the Main temple building and only small portion at South West corner of the temple campus is getting affected. All necessary precautions are being taken to ensure that the Temple is not damaged. At present, there is no proposal to construct flyover at temple location.
