(a)There are total 23 refineries in the country consisting of 19 set up by Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs), 1 by a Joint Venture Company and 3 by Private Companies with a total refining capacity of 249.216 million metric tons per annum (MMTPA). Details are given as under:
