ROAD PROJECTS IN JHARKHAND

2650. SHRI SANJAY SETH:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to construct an elevated road/highway in Ratu, Ranchi, if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be constructed;**
- (b) the areas of Ranchi which are proposed to be included under Bharatmala Pariyojana along with the funds likely to be spent thereon; and**
- (c) the number of toll plazas operating in the State of Jharkhand, district-wise including Ranchi and the amount of revenue collected from toll plazas under Ranchi?**

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) The construction of the Elevated Corridor in Ranchi City from km. 0.000 to km. 3.570 of NH-75 including Down Ramp on NH-23 from km. 0.000 to km. 0.610 has been planned on EPC Mode. The project comprises construction of 4 lane elevated section from Zakir Hussain Park to Piska More on NH-75 and a 2 lane Down Ramp towards NH-23 at Piska More. To decongest Ratu Chowk and Kishore Yadav Chowk, construction of a single lane Up Ramp and Down Ramp have also been envisaged. The estimated cost is about Rs. 534.73 crore with construction period of 2.5 years from date of start and same has been targeted for award in March, 2022.

(b) Projects comprising length of 898 km with cost of Rs. 27,137 crore have been identified for development in the State of Jharkhand under Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I including areas near Ranchi. Out of 898 km, projects comprising length of 454 km have been awarded.

(c) The details such as toll plazas in the State of Jharkhand and toll revenue collection are as under:
