- (a) whether there has been some percentage increase in road construction under Bharatmala Pariyojana in the State of Andhra Pradesh since the inception of the scheme and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) the details of funds sanctioned, allocated and utilised for the purpose during the said period;**
- (c) the present status of the implementation of Raipur - Vizag Economic Corridor project being developed under Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I; and**
- (d) the funds sanctioned for the section of the corridor falling under Andhra Pradesh till date?**

ANSWER

(a) & (b) The Government of India had approved Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I in October, 2017 with an aggregate length of about 34,800 km (including 10,000 km residual National Highways Development Programme stretches) at an estimated outlay of Rs. 5,35,000/- crores. Length of 2,241 km has been envisaged for development under this scheme in the State of Andhra Pradesh. Out of which, works comprising length of 857 km having total cost of Rs. 30,551 crore have been awarded and length of about 311 km has been completed.

(c) & (d) Total length of Raipur- Vizag Economic Corridor is 464 km. Out of this, 356.268 km has been awarded. The corridor length in Andhra Pradesh is 99.629 km which is divided into 4 packages for construction. All 4 packages have been awarded with sanctioned cost of Rs. 3183.09 Cr.
