THIRD PHASE PROJECTS OF DMRC

NO. 2703. SHRI SATYADEV PACHAURI:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) has completed all of its third phase projects and if not, the reasons therefor;**
- (b) the details of phase of work which is going to be executed by the DMRC in the next phase;**
- (c) whether there is any proposal for further extension of the Dwarka-Najafgarh Delhi Metro Rail Line and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (d) the details the total amount of debt repaid by the DMRC till date from its revenues earned?**

ANSWER

(a): Yes, Sir. Delhi Metro Rail Corporation Limited (DMRC) has completed its Phase-III projects and its extensions.

(b): Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) has now planned to execute Phase IV projects comprising six corridors. Out of this, construction of the 03 Priority Corridors sanctioned by Government in July 2019 at the total completion cost of ₹24,948.65 crores has been started and has achieved physical progress of 21.5%. The details of the corridors are as under:

The remaining 03 corridors, as under, proposed by DMRC covering a length of 43.677 km at the total completion cost of ₹12,586.72 crores, have also been taken up for approval.

(c): Dwarka-Najafgarh Delhi Metro line is extended up to Dhansa Bus Stand for a length of 0.891 km having 1 station, which has already been commissioned on 18.09.2021. No further extension has been planned.

(d): DMRC has informed that till date, it has repaid an amount of ₹4187.26 crore towards Japan International Co-operation Agency (JICA) Loan. Apart from this, an interest amount of ₹4012.53 crore has also been paid towards JICA loan.
