- (a)whether the Government proposes to convert Donar to Biraul (SH-56) in Darbhanga and Biraul to Saharsa (SH-17) into four- lanes under PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP); and

#### **ANSWER**

(a) & (b) Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) accorded approval for the implementation of PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan in October, 2021 for providing multimodal connectivity infrastructure to various economic zones. The plan envisages integration of data of all individual Ministries (viz. Railways, Roads, Ports, Waterways, Airports, Mass Transport, Logistics Infrastructure, supported by complementary roles of Energy Transmission, IT Communication, Bulk Water & Sewerage, and Social Infrastructure) in common platform for integrated planning, monitoring and review of projects.

This Ministry is primarily responsible for the development and maintenance of National Highways; the development of State roads including State Highways (SHs) such as Donar to Biraul (SH-56) in Darbhanga and Biraul to Saharsa (SH-17) are the responsibilities of concerned State Governments.
