- (d) whether the Government has any proposal to raise the budget for this scheme as people are facing a financial crisis and private coaching fee is quite high due to the pandemic;

(a)Ministry of Minority Affairs is implementing Naya Savera Yojana to assist students / candidates belonging to the six notified minority communities namely Sikhs, Jains, Muslims, Christians, Buddhists and Parsis by way of special coaching for assisting in qualifying the examinations for technical / professional courses and competitive examination for recruitment to Group 'A', 'B', & 'C' services and other equivalent posts under the Central and State Governments including public sector undertakings, banks, insurance companies as well as autonomous bodies. The scheme is implemented across the country including Uttar Pradesh through empaneled project implementing agencies (PIAs).

So far, 1,19,273 minority students / candidates have benefitted from Naya Savera scheme with financial assistance of Rs. 367.20 crore across the country, which includes 21,688 minority students / candidates from Uttar Pradesh with financial assistance of Rs. 62.69 crore.
