- (a) the norms fixed for establishing Tribal University along with the details thereof;
- (b) the total number of such Tribal University in the country at present;
- (c) the number of tribal students studying in these Universities and the subjects which are being taught there, University-wise;
- (d) whether Ph.D course is available in these Tribal Universities;
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the subjects in which Ph.D is offered, University-wise; and
- (f) the details of various facilities being made available by the University for such Ph.D students?
