- (b)if so, the number of persons migrating to other States in India due to employment related reasons; and
- (c)whether the Government proposes to conduct an annual survey to assess outbound migration between States within in the country; if so, the details thereof and the frequency at which the data will be released?

- (a) & (b): 3,87,499 persons migrated for the purpose of work or employment from Odisha to other States of India as per Census, 2011.
- (c): There is no proposal to conduct annual survey. However, Labour Bureau under Ministry of Labour & Employment has launched an All India Survey of Migrant workers with effect from 01.04.2021.
