- (a) The Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) undertakes conservation and development works of 3693 centrally protected monuments & sites including ancient religious heritage. Conservation and development of monuments is a continuous process and works are taken up depending upon the requirement.
- (b) The ASI undertakes conservation and development works of 291 centrally protected monuments, including ancient religious heritage, located in Madhya Pradesh.
