#### RMSA in Andhra Pradesh

2886. SHRI Y.S. AVINASH REDDY:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of quantum of funds allocated under the Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) during the last five years in the state of Andhra Pradesh, District-wise;
- (b) the details of expenditures incurred under RMSA during the last five years; and
- (c) the current capacity of schools at the primary level to be upgraded to Centres of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education?

(a) As informed by State Government of Andhra Pradesh, funds have been allocated to 13 District Project offices for implementation of the Samagra Shiksha activities (Secondary) erstwhile scheme of RMSA for the year 2019-2020 to 2021-2022 is given below.

The releases from 2017-18 to 2018-19 were made as centralized payments i.e direct to vendors hence no district wise data is available.

(b) As informed by State Government of Andhra Pradesh, the details of expenditure incurred under RMSA during the last five years is as given below:

(c) The Central Government, through integrated centrally sponsored scheme of Samagra Shiksha provides support to the States and UTs for opening/ upgradation of schools as per gaps identified from school mapping. It is mentioned that every financial year, on the basis of state specific school mapping exercise, the state proposes new schools to be upgraded in their respective Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWP&B) for consideration for approval by Project Approval Board (PAB) in Ministry of Education (MOE), accordingly as per availability of fund and rational of the proposal the schools are approved. Under erstwhile Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA), till 2017- 18 and Samagra Shiksha effective from 2018-19, 13093 new secondary schools and 151 new Higher Secondary schools have been sanctioned, out of which States and UTs have reported opening of 12724 new secondary schools and 54 new Higher Secondary schools respectively, till 15.03.2022.
