- (a) the details of the funds allocated and utilized by the Union Government for various cultural assistance and projects in Andaman & Nicobar Islands during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) the details of the ongoing cultural programmes and projects in Andaman & Nicobar Islands; and
- (c) the details of the projects likely to be completed on time and the projects lagging behind schedule along with the reasons therefor?

(a): Government of India has released grant to National Council of Science Museums (NCSM), an autonomous organization of Ministry of Culture for setting up of a Sub-Regional Science Centre, Mayabundar in A&N Islands and an Innovation Hub at Science Centre, Port Blair in A&N Islands under the Scheme for Promotion of Culture of Science (SPOCS) of Govt. of India during the last 3 years:

(b) & (c): After approval for setting up of Science Centre in A&N Islands, Letter of Intent for construction work was issued by NCSM to Public Works Department (PWD), A & N Islands on 5th March, 2019. However, the work at site has not been initiated due to the fact that PWD, A & N Islands is unable to finalise the agency for the work despite two attempts of tendering.
