SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT UNDER AMRUT

NO. 297. SHRI M.K. RAGHAVAN:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of Sewage Treatment Plant at Aavikkal under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban transformation (AMRUT), if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) whether the Government has given any financial support to Kozhikode corporation under AMRUT for the sewage treatment plant at Aavikkal;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and**
- (d) whether the Government is in receipt of any proposal under AMRUT for Kozhikode and if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS

(SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a): Government of Kerala has taken up a 7 MLD (million litre per day) Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) project at Aavikkal under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban transformation (AMRUT). The project was awarded on 22.4.2021 and initial survey has been completed.

(b) and (c): Projects under AMRUT are funded through Central as well as State and Urban Local Body contributions. However, Central shares are not released project or city-wise. Cost of the STP project at Aavikkalis ₹71.57 crore.

(d): Government of Kerala has taken up 50 projects worth ₹306.93 in the city of Kozhikode under AMRUT. Of these, 45 projects worth ₹138.28 crore have been completed and 5 projects worth ₹168.65 crore are under implementation.
