ESI HOSPITALS IN JHARKHAND

2981. DR. NISHIKANT DUBEY:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of beds available in the Employees' State Insurance (ESI) hospitals situated in Jharkhand especially Santhal Pargana of Jharkhand;**
- (b) the sanctioned strength and also the actual strength of staff in the said hospitals;**
- (c) the total amount provided for infrastructure development of the said ESI hospitals during the last three financial years and the current year; and**
- (d) the total number of labourers who got treatment in the said hospitals during the last three years?**

(a) & (b): There are 210 beds in the Employees' State Insurance (ESI) hospitals at Adityapur, Ranchi and Maithan in the state of Jharkhand. ESI has no hospital in Santhal Pargana of Jharkhand.

The sanctioned and filled up strength of the staff in these hospitals are given below:-

(c): The total amount provided for infrastructure development of the ESI hospitals in the state of Jharkhand during financial years 2018-19, 2019-20 & 2020-21 were Rs.25.59 crore, Rs.39.71 crore and Rs.29.89 crore respectively and for the current year (upto January, 22) the amount is Rs.8.60 crore.

(d): The number of ESI beneficiaries who got treatment in these hospitals during the last three years i.e. 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 are 146075, 139167 and 131771 respectively.
