## LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 3109 TO BE ANSWERD ON 22.03.2022

#### **National Sports Federation**

#### 3109. SHRI RAVNEET SINGH BITTU:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has recently approved the continuation of scheme of assistance to National Sports Federation in the country and if so, the details thereof along with the benefits to be accrued to these National Sports Federation by the continuation of this scheme of assistance;
- (b) whether the Government is taking any other measures or developing a comprehensive policy for the improvement in the functioning of the National Sports Federation in the country, if so, the details thereof State/ UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government is taking any measures to improve infrastructure and training facilities at various sports complexes in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise especially in Punjab?

#### **ANSWER**

### THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS [SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR]

(a) Yes, Sir. Strengthening its support for sports in India, the Union Government has approved continuation of Scheme of Assistance to National Sports Federations (NSFs) with an outlay of Rs. 1575 crore for XV Finance Commission Cycle (2021-22 to 2025-26). Under this Scheme, financial support is extended NSFs for conduct of national coaching camps, procurement of sports equipment and consumables, training of athletes, hiring of foreign

coaches and high performance directors, preparation and participation of Indian sportspersons / teams held in India and abroad, holding of international sporting events in India, etc.

- (b) The National Sports Development Code of India, 2011 (Sports Code) is already in existence and operational. The Sports Code requires NSFs to follow healthy management practices, accountability, transparency, impartial and transparent selection procedures, age and tenure restrictions in respect of office bearers, basic universal principles of good governance in sports, proper accounting procedures, prevention of age fraud & sexual harassment of women, and holding of elections as per model guidelines.
- (c) & (d) Yes Sir. Infrastructure facilities in centres of Sports Authority of India (SAI) are upgraded from time to time as per international standards to provide state-of-the-art training facilities to sportspersons. The details of ongoing projects at various SAI centres, across India (including Punjab), are placed at Annexure.
